Most of you are familiar with Change And Be Changed, the non-profit organization founded by the Hangartners in 2014 to provide healthcare and education primarily in Malawi.

CABC has been supported by QAC and now Spiritus since its inception. One of the pillars of the Marianist charism is "to respond to those in need, both near and far."

At our 11/17 gathering, we will be raising funds to support their students in healthcare and education and to purchase a hemo analyzer for Afya Kwanza, a small clinic in southern Tanzania. In addition to collecting financial donations at our gathering, the Hangartners are opening their lake cottage in Harrow, Ontario for a weekend of R&R at a date to be determined, with the donation taking second place to spending time with QAC/Spiritus friends. This would have to be arranged directly with Elisabeth and Thomas.
