### **Looking For Volunteers for Family Promise of Greene County Cooking Ministry**

We are looking for Spiritus MLC volunteers to join the Family Promise of Greene County Cooking Ministry. Specifically, we need at least two or three individuals, one to partner with an existing cooking team (Nimfa Simpson) and one or two others to serve as back up meal providers when someone is ill or out of town.

This service started as a QAC cooking ministry in 2012. Our Spiritus community expressed the desire to continue with our active involvement in this Cooking Ministry in 2024 as part of our Social Justice Ministry.

Spirtius cooking teams provide meals for one week, four times a year. There are five cooking teams; each team providing the meal for one day of the week, so each team serves a total of 4 meals in a year. A team is usually made up of two households and meal plans are coordinated among the team members. Meals are cooked and prepared at home and delivered to the shelter, before 5:00 p.m. The shelter's location is at 124 South Detroit St., Xenia, Ohio.
