Catholic Relief Services has an extremely urgent request on behalf of the millions of people the Church serves every day.

Last week, the Administration released an Executive Order pausing U.S. foreign assistance for a 90-day review period to ensure that all foreign aid is aligned with the Administration's goals to make the U.S. safer, stronger, and more prosperous. Subsequently, almost all foreign aid and development programs have received immediate stop-work orders, interrupting the flow of life-saving assistance to vulnerable communities around the world.

They are asking for people to send letters requesting that they resume foreign assistance programs while they are under review.
