Lenten Donations

At our Spiritus gatherings on 3/16 and 4/6, we will be collecting Lenten donations.

FAMILY PROMISE- diapers (size 5,6,7), "any and all cleaning supplies", napkins, bleach/Lysol, Kool-Aid, hair brushes/combs, plastic cutlery, aluminum foil.

BRIGID'S PATH - 4 Oz Dr Brown bottles, hand sanitizer, scent-free detergent (Dreft), Pampers Swaddlers Sensitive -1 and NB, paper towels, baby wipes, copy paper, toilet paper, Desitin (purple box), Clorox or Lysol disinfectant wipes, single serve coffee pods, dry snacks (granola bars, chips, etc), sturdy paper plates, baby teethers, postage stamps, hand soap refill bottles.

DAKOTA CENTER BABY SHOWER - diaper bags, backpacks, baby shampoo and lotion, onesies, sleepers, hats, diapers (sizes NB-5), baby wipes

For moms - deodorant, toothpaste, lotion, nursing pads

In addition to filling bags with shelf stable snacks, please consider adding a few of these items during the winter months, either in the same bag as the snacks, or in a separate Ziploc bag that can be given out separately. Suggested items include: lip balm, throat lozenges, travel size hand lotion, band aids, masks, toothbrush, travel size toothpaste, or hand warmers.

The Dakota Center is seeking donations and volunteers for their Baby Shower on Saturday April 19th from 11-2 pm. They need 5-10 volunteers to help with the resource fair to direct moms to the organizations. Also please consider collaborating with your community to fill a laundry basket, diaper bag, or backpack with items for baby or mom! Suggestions for the baby bag include baby shampoo and lotion, onesies, sleepers, hats, and of course lots of diapers (size newborn-5) and wipes!
